

NEW FILM STUDIO OPENS

RKO-Pathé, Inc., Has Complete Facilities at Park Avenue Site

The new motion-picture studio of RKO-Pathé, Inc., in the ten-story building at Park Avenue and 106th Street will be opened today. The studio has complete facilities for the production of full-length and documentary films.

Frederic Ullman, president of the corporation, announced that many of the operations, which were conducted formerly at 625 Madison Avenue, have been transferred during the year to the larger site. The equipment includes laboratories, studios, dressing rooms and sound stages, used in the production of complete films.

Known for the documentary series, "This Is America," the company is now engaged in presenting the career of Alexander Graham Bell, inventor of the telephone, in a documentary film, entitled, "Mr. Bell."
